CPRS – Carbon Pollution Reduction Scheme

In a bid to reduce carbon emissions, governments are seeking to introduce ways to change behaviour. Making the large amount of change required in the short time period necessary to combat catastrophic climate change is a major problem for governments. Carbon reduction policies force industries and populations to change how they do business. Such policies therefore, are inherently unpopular making it difficult for governments to implement climate change policies.

- I what climate change means for infrastructure and planning; and
