The RTSA and the NZ Transportation Group are delighted to host Megan Drayton from TRACKSAFE NZ and Marinus La Rooij from AECOM to discuss recent research targeting the views and concerns of heavy vehicle drivers on railway level crossing safety (<http://www.tracksafe.co.nz/news/research-highlights-concerns-at-level-crossings>).

The presentation is being held at Engineering New Zealand in Wellington but will also be broadcast as a webinar.

The research was carried out by Wellington-based research company UMR for rail safety organisation TRACKSAFE NZ, in collaboration with KiwiRail, NZ Transport Agency and the Road Transport Forum. The study is the first in New Zealand to specifically focus on the views of truck drivers operating on and around railway level crossings, and included a survey of around 400 drivers measuring their knowledge and behaviours around level crossings. This was followed by focus groups in Auckland, Christchurch and Palmerston North that further explored the perceptions, attitudes and knowledge of drivers.
